The next block is the message precedence that is assigned and tells you how quickly needs to be handled. The next block is the message handling instructions on how to deliver it to the recipient. The next block is the check block, the number of words in the body. The next block is the place of origin of the of the message. The next block is the time of file for the message. The last block is the date of the message.

The next block is the address block. This is the recipient of the message, name, place of residence and phone number and maybe an email address.

The next block is the body of the message. This is comprised of 25 words or less for the message. This is followed by the signature of the originator.

Chris wants to have a simulated message traffic net for the next net. Everyone is to try and come up with a simple message to pass on the net.

Neil didn't have a lot for the net. Was grateful for the refresher on the radiogram form. Everyone is doing fine just struggling with some flu bug.
